- Next we will explain what a Dutch qualification looks like utilizing the qualification 'Hospitality/ Bakery Entrepreneur 2007-2008. We will discuss the necessary competences, task-analysis and the performance indicators.
- The Europass Mobility Document and the Europass Certificate Supplement will be presented using the same qualification.
- Two students who did their internships Hospitality/Bakery Entrepreneur abroad, will share with us their experiences.
