Memorandum of understanding on post project cooperation

This Memorandum of Understanding on cooperation (MOU) sets for the terms and understanding between respected partners in the Learning by Doing project Partnership.

1.

This document outlines the terms and conditions of the potential future partnership between education institutions, enterprises, national and regional authorities, business associations, Nongovernmental organizations and other interested parties, each referred to hereafter as a "Partner" and collectively "The Learning by Doing Observatory Initiative".

2.

(Background and Purpose)

Partners find a transnational network of VET promotion organizations founded by the Danube WBL partners in order to promote WBL in VET and to serve the continuous improvement process of VET with professional services.

The national branches of the WBL Observatory are to deliver information on WBL, organize marketing activities of good practices and services in WBL and provide study visit opportunities to partner countries.

The purpose of this MOU is to set forth the understandings and intentions of the partners with regard to collaboration in areas of mutual concern mentioned herein.

3.

(Objective)

The main objective of The Learning by Doing Partnership is to contribute and promote WBL in VET and to serve the continuous improvement process of VET systems with professional services and support.

4.

Partners to this MOU agree to work together to support of the initiative of Learning by Doing Observatory. Partners seek to share their respective strengths and experience with the collective goals.

Partners will share lessons learned from an extensive body of knowledge and data to support The Learning by Doing Partnership.

V.

(General Provisions)

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as superseding or interfering in any way with other agreements or contracts entered into between the partners unrelated to this MOU, either prior to or subsequent to the signing of the MOU.

The partners further specifically acknowledge that this MOU does not create an obligation to commitment of funds, nor does it constitute a legally binding commitment by any of the partners.

This MOU shall not be deemed to create any legal relationship of agency, partnership, or joint venture between Partners, and the Partners shall make no such representation to anyone.

This MOU shall take effect upon the signature of Partners effective as of the date signed by the last Participant to sign and shall have a duration until there are interested partners.

This MOU may be amended or modified by written agreement of the Partners.

Any Partner may terminate this MOU at any time upon at least 30 days written notice to the other Partner(s) with such termination becoming effective upon the date set forth in such written notice.


