Keynote Speaker

Keith Brumfitt has assisted the EQAVET network since 2009. This has included working in every Member State and supporting the development of peer learning and peer review. In 2022 he supported four international peer reviews for the EQAVET network and he is currently working with five EQAVET National Reference Points in relation to their peer reviews in 2023. From 2018-22 he supported VET providers in Ireland and the UK with the development and implementation of peer reviews. Prior to working as an education consultant, Keith held senior leadership roles in three government agencies in the UK and a UK university.

In this project Transnational Peer Review Criteria for Vocational Education and Training in Europe have been developed and the Peer Review process at VET Providers level has been piloted (2019-2021). The development work has been carried out as a joint project by the quality assurance national reference points of Finland, Croatia and Slovenia and in collaboration with Estonia (HAKA). In the EQAVET project 2021-2023 the use of the Peer Review method and the handbook with QA criteria has been promoted.
